## CODE OF ETHICS

The Canadian Kennel Club is incorporated under the Animal Pedigree Act to be responsible for the registration, preservation and promotion of all CKC recognized breeds of dogs in Canada.

The Canadian Kennel Club is a national membership organization representing purebred dog activities. The Board of Directors of The Canadian Kennel Club are elected from the membership representing their regional zones and are responsible to that membership.

In order to achieve the goals and objectives of The Canadian Kennel Club, its members agree to adhere to the following principles:

- All members of The Canadian Kennel Club will comply with the By-laws, rules and regulations established by the Board of Directors of The Canadian Kennel Club and the requirements of the *Animal Pedigree Act*;
- All members of The Canadian Kennel Club will provide their dogs with appropriate housing, food and health care as outlined in the Canadian Veterinary Medical Association's "Code of Practice for Canadian Kennel Operations";
- All members of The Canadian Kennel Club will endeavour to enhance the role of the purebred dog in society as an essential member of its communities where it functions as a companion, a guardian, a healer, a hunter, a herder, a teacher and, above all, "man's best friend";
- In order to preserve and enhance each breed's characteristics The Canadian Kennel Club supports and encourages participation in shows, trials and other events. All members, whether they be exhibitors, handlers, judges or assistants will participate in such activities with honesty, fairness and integrity, ever mindful of the practice of "good sportsmanship";
- Except as provided in the By-laws of The Canadian Kennel Club, all members as breeders of purebred dogs, will include in their programs, only Canadian Kennel Club registered (or registerable) stock which will strengthen the genetic pool and, thus, guarantee further progression toward the ideals of the standard, keeping authentic records of their activities;
- All members of The Canadian Kennel Club will undertake the task of educating and encouraging all newcomers to the world of purebred dogs no matter their interest: pet-owner, exhibitor, trialer or breeder.

## MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

### Conditions of Membership

- Full adherence to the CKC Code of Ethics and Code of Practice, *By-laws*, rules, regulations, policies and procedures, basic objects and principles of the Club.
- No record of conviction on a charge of cruelty to animals.
- Non-involvement in the buying, selling or breeding of dogs which are not purebred.
- No record of suspension or expulsion from any foreign, CKC recognized registry body or any other body incorporated under the *Animal Pedigree Act*.
- Authorization for CKC to perform a formal credit search (Regular Category Members).
- Member Credit Accounts paid within the prescribed due date period (Regular Category Members).
- Payment of annual membership fee.

### Categories and Classes of Memberships

#### 1. Regular Category

**Primary Class:** The main membership that receives full Club benefits and the subscription to *Dogs in Canada* magazine.

**Household Class:** Any person who is part of the same household as the Primary Member (i.e. spouses, significant others and children under the age of 19). Full Club benefits are accorded to each Household Member, except the magazine subscription. Household Memberships cannot exist on their own. They must be associated with a Primary Membership.

**Senior Class:** Available to those individuals 65 years of age or older. Official proof of age is required.

#### 2. Associate Category:

**Companion Class:** For the dog lover. Membership includes a subscription to *Dogs in Canada* monthly magazine, membership card, the newsletter *Companions*, and access to CKC affiliate value-added programs including preferred insurance, credit card and long distance rates.

**Junior Class:** Perfect to teach children about purebred dogs and CKC. Membership includes a membership card; Free Event Pass; Junior Member Newsletter; and more.

**Fellow Class:** For those who may not own purebred dogs but want to support the fancy. Membership includes a membership card, the newsletter *Companions* and access to CKC affiliate value-added programs including preferred insurance, credit card and long distance rates.

(Note: Associate memberships do not carry voting privileges, they do not count toward Life Membership tenure and they do not meet "member" requirements under any CKC rule, regulation, policy, procedure or guideline.)

### Membership Privileges - applies to Regular Category memberships only

- Voting privileges are bestowed on a Regular member after 3 years. At that time, a Regular member may stand for election to the Board of Directors. The minimum voting age for a Regular Club member is 19, and voting privileges are extended to Canadian residents only.

Note: All fees, for residents and non-residents alike, are subject to Goods and Services Tax (GST) at the current rate, other than for residents of New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Newfoundland, whose fees shall instead be subject to Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) at the current rate.

- A Household Class membership cannot exist without a Primary Class membership being in place.
- Primary Class members under the age of majority (18 yrs) cannot legally be granted credit privileges.
- Primary and Senior class memberships include a subscription to *Dogs in Canada* monthly magazine at the current subscription rate, a copy of *Dogs in Canada Annual* at current value and the *CKC Official Section* monthly magazine at current value.
- Companion class membership includes a subscription to *Dogs in Canada* monthly magazine at the current subscription rate and a copy of *Dogs in Canada Annual* at current value.
- All memberships except Companion are for the calendar year and renewal fees are due and payable by December 15th. Regrettably, membership fees cannot be prorated and back issues of *Dogs in Canada* monthly magazine are not generally available.
